Together, you and your Investment Advisor are planning your financial future. Now you can keep track of the progress you're making towards achieving your financial goals from the convenience of your personal computer.



Online account access

With DS Online, your current account information is at your fingertips 24 hours a day, seven days a week. All you need is a computer with secure Internet access.

Once you're connected, you can quickly find out the market value of each individual holding in your accounts. Plus, you can determine the total market value of each of your accounts. Values are updated based on the last bid prices from the previous business day.

You can also check the status of your trade orders without having to wait for confirmations in the mail.

Access real-time quotes

Detailed real-time quotes for stocks and options listed on Canadian and U.S. markets – plus daily closing prices for mutual funds – are available through DS Online. With our real-time stock quote service, you can find out the current market price for securities listed on major North American exchanges and the change from the previous day's close.

For each security, we also provide bid and ask prices, the 52-week price range and the price-to-earnings multiple. As well, you can access the latest data on dividends, volume, earnings and yield.

Create a “watchlist”

You can create customized “watchlists” of up to 15 securities you want to track for any reason – even ones you do not own. This includes stocks, options and mutual funds.

Investment resources at your fingertips

Through your DS Online home page, you have convenient access to your account information and timely market updates. Get real-time quotes for stocks, options and mutual funds in up to 15 "Watchlists" that you create yourself.

View the market value of each individual holding in your accounts, and the total market value of each of your accounts.

Plus, check the status of your trade orders and account activity quickly and conveniently.


Secure and private online account access
